Who reflect on learning scenarios?

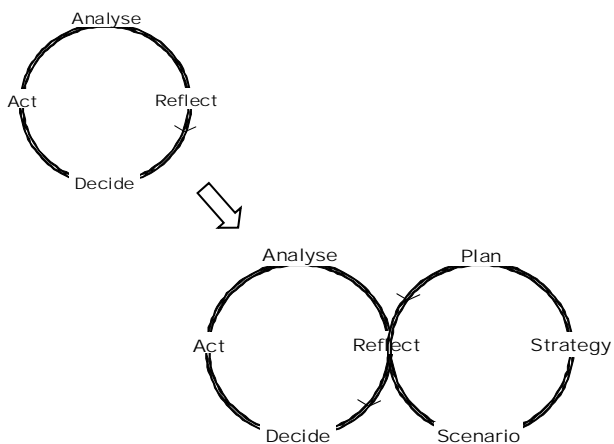
- Educators
